- Receives food orders and prepares food according to specifications by using approved recipes, proper portioning and food prep logs/tools
- Conducts regular visual and taste tests to ensure food is of the highest quality and prepared according to specifications
- Restocks front line with prepared product during peak volumes and/or in accordance with time and temperature
- Adheres to food safety standards
- Prepares food volume based on sales compared to existing inventory and incoming orders
- Frequently cleans the kitchen area including grill and equipment
- Assists in managing inventory control
