**Position Summary:** The **San Pasqual Economic Development Corporation** is looking for experienced part-time Team Members for multiple work shifts at the Horizon Fuel Center. Responsible for providing service that invites interaction with our guests by processing payments for goods and services and educating guests about the offerings at the convenience store. Ensures that the fuel center is clean and always inviting to guests and can work in a fast-paced environment.

## **Principal Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Acknowledges, engages and interacts with guests and other team members; anticipates and exceeds guests' needs
- Processes goods and services accurately by using the point of sale system; issues refunds for returned merchandise
- Receives cash and credit card payments and issues receipts or change to guests; responsible for overages and shortages, accuracy and security
- Addresses guest needs and concerns
- Clean and disinfect restroom facilities, including sinks, toilets, and urinals, fill dispensers with soap, toilet paper, and other items; clean mirrors, walls, light fixtures, and windows; unclog drains and toilets
- Clean and disinfect service islands and fuel pumps
- Dispense propane while observing all industry safety standards
- Report safety, sanitary, and fire hazards to appropriate personnel
- Stocks products and monitors inventory of Pit Stop Market
- Frequently cleans the Horizon Fuel Center
- Maintains the Horizon Fuel Center brand image by ensuring a functional fuel center, the accurate processing of payments from guests, fuel center cleanliness, and excellent guest service



## **Education, Experience, Qualifications, and Skills:**

- Previous cashier experience is helpful
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Ability to communicate in English is required; Spanish comprehension is helpful
- Fundamental reading, writing, math, and computer/POS skills are required
- Must have access to adequate transportation to and from job site
